WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Christopher J. Martineau and Kaitlin Martineau f/k/a Kaitlin Sapack, husband and wife, of 72 W Portsmouth Street, Concord, NH 03301, for consideration paid grant to Maxwell Nagel, single, of 95 Gage Road, Bedford, NH 03110, with WARRANTY COVENANTS:

A certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situate in Concord, County of Merrimack, and State of New Hampshire, and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning on the northeasterly side of the West Portsmouth Road, so-called, formerly known as Pecker Street in East Concord at a point eighty-five (85) feet northwesterly of the corner of land now or formerly of Robert Eastman; thence northerly along said West Portsmouth Road to land sold to Henry S. Thatcher by William P. Ford on July 27, 1864; thence northeasterly by said Thatcher land; thence turning and running in a straight line South $48 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East to a point eighty-five (85) feet more or less from said Eastman land where a stake is to be placed at the northeast corner of land conveyed by said LaRochelle to Marion R. and Everett J. Sanborn Jr. by Warranty deed of even date; thence running westerly along said Sanborn land to West Portsmouth Road at the point of beginning.

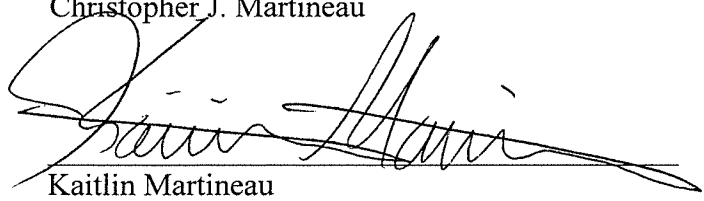

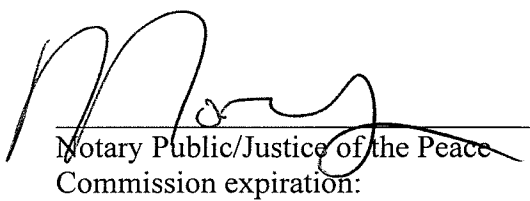
